DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farmhouse is located south of Maryland Route 68 east of I-81 near Williamsport in Washington County. A two story, two bay brick building with a pair of four bay attached wings or dependencies, it faces east.

The house has been extensively altered with numerous exterior additions. Bricks at the front elevation of the main section are laid in Flemish bond while other elevations display common bonding. The entire structure rests on low stone foundations. Windows have narrow frames with six over one pane sashes. Projecting bays and an enclosed porch all added, have changed the building's fenestration. Original openings in the first story of the north wing have been completely removed in the installation of a two car garage.

The main entrance is located in the south end bay of the main section. The door is elaborate with a broad elliptical fan and side lights. Double brick chimneys linked with a parapet are located inside the north end wall of the main section. A corbeled brick cornice finishes the eaves.

A small one story kitchen with an exterior brick chimney is attached to the two story bay wing at the south of the main section.

A barn is located northeast of the house and the farm contains 178.6 acres.


