DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farm is located on the east side of King Road, southwest of Boonsboro in Washington County, Maryland. The buildings are situated on high ground with the principal facade of the house facing west. Two modern gambrel roofed barns are located north of the dwelling.

A two story, three bay structure sheathed with German siding, the house is possibly of log construction. To its north end wall is attached a one story, four bay brick wing which is oriented toward the east.

Windows and doors appear to have been spaced evenly in the walls of the main section. At both levels windows have six over six pane double hung sashes held within narrow frames with applied trim. Six over six windows are also used in the brick section. The main entrance is located in the north end bay of the front or west elevation. The door is modern and appears to have had a transom at one time. Extending across the entire front elevation is a shed roofed porch resting on a modern base. A pair of doors are located side by side in the center bays of the east elevation of the brick section. Each door appears to have had a transom.

The roof of each section is sheathed with sheet metal, standing seam tin being used on the brick section. Brick chimneys are located inside the end walls.

The building appears to be in good to excellent condition and stands on a tract containing 111.43 acres.


