DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>This house is located along the west side of old Route 66, a short distance south of Interstate 70 in the village of Beaver Creek in Washington County, Md. Like other houses in this small town, it is situated on a rise of ground above the Beaver Creek and faces east or toward the road.</p> <p>The structure is a one-and-a-half story, three-bay log dwelling painted brown and white with dark green trim.</p> <p>Set on low stone foundations, the wall are of squared hewn logs which display "V" notched corner joining. The surface of the logs has been painted brown while the space between is concrete which has been painted white. There is no decorative work associated with the exterior wall construction.</p> <p>Windows are present on all sides of the building. The narrow frames appear to be modern and hold six-over-six pane double-hung sashes. Most windows are flanked by board shutters.</p> <p>The main entrance is located in the second bay of the front elevation, slightly south of the center of the wall. The doorway is simple and without decorative trim.</p> <p>The roof appears to have been raised several inches above the original plate. A shed roof double dormer projects from the east slope of the roof. A modern exterior chimney of brick rises from the southwest corner of the house.</p> <p>A leanto addition is present at the rear or west side of the building.</p> <p>The house is in excellent condition and stands on a 33' X 40' lot of ground.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The area of significance of this building is its architecture. Although altered it does provide an example of Washington County's log building tradition.

Many log structures were built in Washington County from the earliest days of settlement to well into the 19th century. A number of these buildings continue in use today although many are disguised by various forms of siding or bricks.

These structures are worthy of note as representatives of a major architectural group in Western Maryland and the Cumberland Valley.


