Description

Located on the east side of North Main Street, immediately south of Bell Lane, this L-shaped frame house is a two story, three bay German sided structure with a central cross gable. It seems to have been refurbished in the 1890-1910 period as its appearance suggests that date. However, a house of approximately the same size and shape is located on the 1877 Atlas, at this site. The central entrance is protected by a one story front porch extending across the facade. It is supported by turned posts with brackets and elaborate gingerbread trim. Windows have single pane sash.

The house on this site was in 1877, the last house on the east side of North Main Street. It is a well preserved and intact example of its type.


