Description

This brick house dates from approximately 1850. Shown on the 1877 Atlas, it is a 1½ story, three bay brick house on limestone foundations that become almost a full story in height at the rear of the building. Windows have six over six pane sash in narrow frames. The main entrance is in the center bay and includes a transom. Chimneys are located inside the end walls. A porch across the front probably dates from about 1900, but is supported by modern metal columns.

A modest vernacular structure of the mid-19th century, this house is typical of the period and region. The 1877 Atlas shows the owner as E. Mades.

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
