Description

This 1½ story brick house, like its neighbor to the north, is built into a steep slope and consequently has a fully exposed basement wall at the front elevation. The foundation is of stone while the rest of the house is brick. A later shed dormer was added to the roof. It is a four bay house with two central entrances side by side, a plan common in areas where German influence is strong. A high porch accessed by stairs at the north end shelters the main story and basement. Windows have either six over six or single pane sash.

C.M. Keedy is said to have been the builder in 1854, and he is shown as the owner on the 1877 Atlas. A post office was housed in the basement.






