Description

A two story, three bay L-shaped brick house, this structure has been substantially modified. The bricks are laid in common bond and the surfaces have been sandblasted. A modern block and frame commercial front and south side extension have been added. Some windows retain original wide wooden lintels and two over two light sash. Chimneys are located inside the end walls.

Probably dating from the 1870s, this property was purchased by Robert Line in 1908 and made into a store. The 1877 Atlas shows a building on this site owned by S. Eversole.




