Description

Located on the east side of South Main Street is this two story, three bay brick house with a central cross gable. It is a hipped roof structure with single pane sash windows beneath segmentally arched heads. The main entrance is located in the south end bay of the front elevation. A porch supported by turned posts extends across the entire front.

Although this house appears to post-date 1877, an L-shaped building belonging to R. Snyder is shown here on the Atlas map of that year.
