Description

This L-shaped common bond brick house is two stories high and four bays wide. The L extension to the rear and four gabled dormers across the front are additions. Windows have six over one pane sash beneath wide wooden lintels. Chimneys are located inside the end walls.

This is one of several mid 19th century brick houses located in Keedysville. In 1877 the property belonged to J.L. Snively and included a blacksmith shop south of the house.




