Description

A two story, three bay, L-shaped brick house, this structure dates from the 1850s. Its windows have six over six pane sash beneath wide wood lintels. The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation. An early 20th century porch supported by doric columns extends across the front. The roof is covered with standing seam sheet metal and chimneys are located inside the end walls.

According to both the 1877 Atlas map and local historians this house was occupied by first J.A. then Oscar Grossnickle who had a wagon shop just north of the house.






