Description

This brick house which appears to date from the 1890s is a two story, five bay structure. Openings have segmentally arched tops, typical of the 1890s, and two over two pane windows. The main entrance is located in the center bay and includes an elliptical transom and sidelights. A porch supported by doric columns extends across the entrance front. Chimneys extend from inside the end walls.

Although this house appears to date from the 1890s, there was a building on the site earlier, as shown on the 1877 Atlas map. It was the home and presumably office of Dr. P.D. Fahrney, who, according to the Atlas' business directory was a "Uroscopian Physician and druggist. Chronic and Private diseases made a specialty." According to local historians, the present house was built by the Pry family.


