Description

This 1920s bungalow is a one and a half story, three bay brick structure with a deeply overhanging roof forming the front porch. The porch is supported by four brick piers. Paired windows are located on either side of a central entrance. A shed roofed dormer with two pairs of windows extends from the roof.

According to local historians, this was built by Poffenbergers when they retired from farming. It is likely to be a catalogue house since many bungalows like this one were. It is one of several such houses at the edges of Keedysville. Much of the early 20th century development in Keedysville was a result of retiring farmers moving into town.

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


