Description

This house, near the south edge of Keedysville is a two story, three bay frame structure with a shed extension at the rear. Its walls are covered with insul siding. Windows have single pane sash. A semi-hexagonal projecting bay extends from the south end. A porch across the front is supported by turned posts.

This house reflects Keedysville's later development in the early 20th century. It is said to have been built by the Valentine family.


