Description

Located at the north side of Mt. Briar Road, facing south is this two story, three bay frame house dating from the turn of the century period. The house is covered with vinyl siding and there is an addition at the rear. Windows have single pane sash and the entrance is centrally placed.

This house represents the late 19th and early 20th century development of Keedysville, most of which is located at the edges of town.


