No. 420 N. Main Street is a two-story, three-bay-wide, frame, side-gabled, detached, single-family dwelling on a solid rubblestone foundation. There is a single, brick, interior chimney. The roof is clad in asphalt shingle; the house is sided in vinyl siding. There is a one-story, one-bay, gable-roofed porch. The single-leaf door is flanked with sidelights. Southwest of house is an outbuilding built into the bank. The outbuilding has raised a rubblestone foundation and frame gable-roofed superstructure. A concrete block addition with hip roof and brick chimney extend the outbuilding to the west. This house, though modified in the late-twentieth-century, appears to date to the early twentieth century. Its general form and original outbuilding are intact. This house is a contributing resource to the Town of Boonsboro Historic District.

420 North Main Street is an east-facing, two-and-a-half-story, three-bay, freestanding, residential structure. The building, which is close to the public-right-of-way, rests on a stone foundation and is covered with manufactured siding which may be obscuring an old structure. The building is either relatively new or has been totally remodeled. It has a side-gable roof with open eaves and one chimney. The north-bay entrance is protected by a vinyl portico. A porch extends across the south facade. Windows are double-hung replacements with shutters.
