#### Summary:

This frame or log building stands 1 ½ stories in height. The five bay long dwelling has a central brick chimney. A modern porch, one and a half stories high extends along most of the front elevation. A one story kitchen wing extends to the rear.

This frame or log building stands 1 ½ stories in height. The five bay long building faces north. A modern porch shelters the full height of the main façade. A one story addition adjoins the rear. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles. Vinyl siding and modern windows along with the porch have altered the original appearance and historic integrity of the house.






Tax Map 67, P. 129
