Based on the available information, the house at 3641 Harpers Ferry Road, located south of Sharpsburg, does not appear to meet the National Register Criteria for individual listing. The modest frame house, which probably dates to the late 19th century, is a common rural house type for the area and period. It does not appear to possess any particular architectural significance and is not known to have been associated with any significant events or people. The house is located well outside the eligible Sharpsburg Historic District.
