The single-family dwelling at 17801 Spielman Road in Fairplay, Washington County, MD is not located within an historic district and is not considered eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

The 1-1/2-story frame (or concrete block? in places) dwelling was probably constructed in the first quarter of this century. It is a long, lowing building, six bays long and one bay deep and covered with a gable roof. The residence has undergone major alterations, including an enclosed front porch which greatly detracts from the original character of the dwelling. The house lacks the architectural distinctiveness and integrity to qualify for listing under Criterion C. The property is not known to have associations with persons or events significant to our past and is thus not eligible under Criteria A or B.


