DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame and log house is located on the south side of Cool Hollow Road, southeast of Hagers town and Funkstown in Washington County, Maryland. It is situated on an area of level ground and faces north. It is a two story, three bay German sided building resting on low stone foundations. It would appear to be of log construction. Perpendicular to this front section is a two story four bay wing which also may be of log construction at the first story and of frame at the second story level. Behind this is a one story, one bay frame outkitchen. A semi-hexagonal projecting bay was added to the east elevation of the wing.

Window treatment varies. At the front section frames are narrow holding two over two pane sashes at the first story of the entrance elevation and a nine over six sash in the west end wall at the first story. Second story windows have six over six sashes. At the wing windows at the first story are quite small with two over two sashes while those above have single pane sashes and are considerably larger. Most openings in the wing are trimmed with early 20th century period flat topped architraves.

The main entrance is located in the central bay of the front elevation and includes a naray transom above the door. The wing has a double porch along its west elevation with entrances opening onto both levels.

The roof is sheathed with slates which have three courses of decorative imbrication on the north slope. Small brick chimneys with corbeling at their tops are located inside the end walls and at the interior of the wing. Another flue extends from the outkitchen.

Near the house is a small frame bank barn. The buildings appear to be in excellent condition.
