DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This small farmstead is located on the side of Toms Road east of Beaver Creek between Funkstown and Boonsboro in Washington County, Maryland. The house is situated on a slope and faces south. It is a two story, three bay log house resting on fieldstone foundations sheathed with concrete. The walls are completely covered with composition siding, but log construction is suggested by the thickness of the door and window jambs. A one story, two bay extension with concrete block foundations is attached to the south end.

Windows are placed at random in the walls. They have wide frames which hold two over two pane double hung sashes. Only two windows are present at the second story level of the front elevation. The front door is located in the central bay at the first story but is directly beneath the south end bay of the second story. The door frame is simple and there is no transom.

A porch extends across the front elevation of the house. It is supported by square posts resting on concrete block foundations.

The roofing material is corrugated sheet metal. A small brick chimney extends from the interior of the house near its center.

East of the house is a small frame bank barn and an outbuilding with an exterior stone and brick chimney.

The buildings appear to be in fair condition and stand on a small farm containing 25.84 acres.


