DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This small farmstead is located on the east side of Toms Road just north of its junction with Benevola Church Road north of Boonsboro in Washington County, Maryland. The buildings are located near the side of the road and face south.

The house is a rectangular late 19th century brick structure with stone foundations, four bays long and two wide. Bricks are laid in common bond at all elevations. Flat arches are present above the windows which have narrow frames with six over six pane sashes. They have pairs of shutters with movable louvers. Entrances with transoms are located in the south and west end walls.

A one story porch is supported by round doric type pillars and extends along the west and south elevations.

The house has a hipped roof surfaced with sheet metal.

West of the house along the edge of Toms Road is a small log barn with its wall construction exposed. Much of the chinking and daubing consisting of small pieces of wood and lime mortar respectively has fallen away. The logs display inverted "V" notched corner joining.

A frame barn is located behind the small log structure.

The property contains 35 acres.


