DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame house and stone barn are located on the west side of U.S. 40-A at Cool Hollow, south of Funkstown in Washington County, Maryland. The house is situated on a slight hill and faces east. It is a two story, three bay balloon frame building with a two story, two bay ell extending to the rear. It is sheathed with German siding.

Windows have early 20th century style flat topped architraves with two over two pane sashes. At the front elevation, windows are not aligned with each other and there are only two windows at the upper story level. The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation. A hipped roof porch supported by square posts and partially enclosed by a plain balustrade is present at the two north bays of the front wall.

The roof is sheathed with standing seam sheet metal and extends beyond the end walls. A small brick chimney is located at the interior of the front section of the house and another is located inside the end wall of the ell.

North of the house is a large stone bank barn which appears much older than the house.

The buildings seem to be in good condition and stand on a tract of land planned for residential development.
