DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This former Harmony Hill School is located at the end of a private lane extending in an easterly direction from U.S. Route 40-A near Benevola north of Boonsboro in Washington County, Maryland. It faces south. The school building is now used as a private residence. It is a one story, three bay brick structure resting on low fieldstone foundations. The surface of the building has been painted grey and displays American bonding. A 20th century frame addition has been added to the east wall.

Windows are large and have nine over six pane sashes. The main entrance is located in the south gable wall and a small window is present next to the door. A 20th century hipped roof porch supported by square posts extends across the front of the building.

The roof extends beyond the end walls and is sheathed with pressed tin shingles. A chimney is located against the east wall.

The school appears to be in fair to good condition.


