DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farm is located at the end of a private lane which extends in an easterly direction from Black Rock Road north of I-70 and southeast of Hagerstown in Washington County, Maryland.

The house is a one and a half story, three bay stone building with a one story stone and concrete block addition to the rear. The house faces north. A date stone in its west gable is inscribed with the date 1780 or 90 and the initials S. C. The building is constructed of small sized hammer faced coursed limestones with flat arches above the windows and doors. Wide wooden frames, their joints secured with pegs are present. The actual windows, doors and the roof covering are all recent. A stuccoed chimney is located inside the east end.

A modern dairy barn is located south of the house.


