This house is located on the west side of the Boonsboro-Mt. Lena Road on the west slope of South Mountain, north of Boonsboro in Washington County, Maryland. It stands on sloping ground and faces east. It is a one and a half story three bay brick building with a date stone inscribed with the year 1854 and the name Grossnickel.

Common bond brickwork is exhibited at all elevations.

Openings have narrow frames with wide wooden lintels.

Modern shed additions extend around the building.


