DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farm is located at the end of a private lane which extends in an easterly direction from Poffenberger Road northwest of Keedysville in Washington County, Maryland.

The house is a two story, five bay frame structure with a two story, four bay ell extending to the rear. The surface of the building is sheathed with German siding. Openings have architraves with late 19th century pointed top pieces. Interior woodwork is massive and would appear to date from the third quarter of the 19th century.

Also present on the property is a frame bank barn and a stone outkitchen which may predate the other structures.


