This farm is located on the west side of King Road, southwest of Boonsboro in Washington County, Maryland. The house is a two story, four bay German sided frame building. Two front doors are located side by side in the central bays of the principal elevation. Windows have two over two pane sashes with curved upper lights. A frame bank barn is located some distance northwest of the house.


