




 This stone culvert has no known association with events or persons, thus disqualifying it for eligibility under Criteria A and B of the National Register of Historic Places. While typical of a type of arched culvert found in mountainous areas and Washington County, its design is not particularly distinctive, thus disqualifying it for eligibility under Criterion C. Criterion D, information potential, was not evaluated in the course of this study.



DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This single arched culvert carries Clevelandtown Road across a tributary of Dog Creek about two miles south of Boonsboro along the base of South Mountain in Washington County, Maryland.

The culvert spanning the small run is constructed of roughly coursed stone of a type found in the mountainous areas. More finely dressed stone face the arch. Some poured concrete was used at the base of the culvert, perhaps to increase its depth at a later date. Coping at the top of the side walls is also concrete.

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STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This arched culvert is one of a group of such structures to be found in Washington County. Smaller than the County's much arched stone bridges, these small spans over narrow streams are often unnoticed on rural roads. They may be contemporary with other stone bridges in the County, most of which date from between 1820 and 1860.
