DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farmstead is located at the end of a private lane which extends in a westerly direction from Maryland Route 67 and east of King Road, about one and a half miles south of Boonsboro in Washington County, Maryland. The house faces west. It is a two story three bay German sided structure of frame or log construction.

Windows have two over two pane sashes with the upper panes having curved tops. The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation and is reached by a flight of wooden steps leading to a small porch. Some distance north of the house is a frame bank barn.


