DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This complex is located on the north side of Marble Quarry Road southeast of Keedysville in Washington County, Maryland.

The house is a three part stone and log structure which faces west or perpendicular to the roadway. The southern three bays of the house are of stone construction, two stories high. Doors are located at both the first and second story levels. Remaining joists between the stories indicates that a double porch originally extended along the front elevation of this section. The next part of the house is a two story two bay log section which is constructed with four log walls suggesting that it may predate the southern stone section. Logs at its west elevation have been exposed while those to the east and north have been covered with modern reproduction wooden siding. There are now no exterior entrances into this section. Attached to the north end wall of the log structure is a two bay, one story stone wing with an exterior stone chimney. A row of gabled dormers has been added to both the east and west slopes of the roof.

Northwest of the house is a stone spring house and another stone outbuilding near the spring. A large frame bank barn is located on a bluff some distance from the house.
