This farm complex includes a two part log house partially encased with brick. One section is two stories high and three bays in length with a central entrance. The other is one and a half stories high and covered with asbestos shingle siding. It has an off center entrance.

Also present is a log smoke house, ruins of a stone spring house and another building which had an exterior stone chimney.


