DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This brick farmhouse located at the end of Coffman Road is a two story, seven bay structure displaying common bond at all elevations. The four northern bays of the front or east wall are recessed under a double porch which is included beneath the main roof span. Painted in the north gable are the initials M.L., 1854 and J.C. 1916. Openings are topped with wide wooden lintels and six over six pane window sashes are used. Also present is a brick out kitchen, brick smoke house and a frame bank barn.


