DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farmhouse is a two story, three bay log structure sheathed with German siding. A two story, two bay ell, also of log construction extends to the rear. Exterior woodwork and trim includes flat topped architraves, overhanging barge boards and a front porch supported by square posts. These characteristics are typical of early 20th century construction. Two over two pane window sashes are used. Also part of the complex is a stone spring house, frame wagon shed and a modern dairy barn.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This farm complex is difficult to date because of changes to the exterior of the buildings. The house, built of logs, is a typical 19th century vernacular structure. It may predate its Ca. 1900 exterior appearance. According to the present owner, graves of Civil War soldiers were found in a field just across Miller's Sawmill Road from the complex.


