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DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This small log house would appear to have been built in two parts. Set perpendicular to Mills Road with its end wall at the edge of the road, it is a one story, four bay structure. All wall surfaces are sheathed with composition siding.

A large exterior stone chimney topped with brick is built against the end wall.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This house is a typical vernacular log structure which could have been built during the 18th, 19th or 20th centuries. Exterior finishes to the building date from the 20th century but do not appear to be original. Therefore an assessment of the buildings age is difficult without further study. However, the exterior stone chimney on some log houses can be associated with 18th century construction.
