This house is a balloon frame structure dating from the second half of the 19th century. The building is in ruins with windows and doors missing or boarded shut. It is a two story, three bay structure with an ell extension to the rear. Windows and doors are placed irregularly.

A frame bank barn and outbuildings are present.


