STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This building is a typical vernacular dwelling which could date from the 18th, 19th or early 20th centuries. Log was a favored building material in Washington County from the times of early settlement through the late 19th century. Possible early construction is suggested by the exterior chimney.




