DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two story, five bay house is constructed of rock faced concrete block with light colored accent blocks used as quoins at the buildings corners and around the windows. Windows have large single pane sashes topped with segmental arches with prominent keystones. Centered at the second story level of the front elevation is a palladian window above a low porch supported by concrete pillars. A broken hipped roof is present with central cross gables at each facade. The roof is of tile. A small frame barn is present behind the building.


