DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two story five bay stone house was built in sections. Its entire surface is covered with stucco. First story windows have nine over six pane sashes while those at the second story level have six over six panes. The main entrance is located in the central bay. The entrance and the two bays north of it form one part of the house, while the two bays south of it are another section. Behind the house is a log smoke house with a steep hipped roof. A frame bank barn is also present.


