DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is a two story, four bay German sided log dwelling with a four bay frame ell extending to the rear. Exterior finishes to the house reflect the 1890's-1900 period although the actual age of the front log section may be much older. In addition to the house, a number of frame out-buildings are present and a frame bank barn. A picturesque stone fence extends along the lane leading to the buildings and along Taylor's landing which passes in front of the complex.




