**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This long, narrow two story, six bay log house is sheathed with German siding. Extending up its west end wall is an exterior stone and brick chimney. Another stone chimney is located at the interior of the structure. The house was built in several sections, possibly as many as three parts. Features visible from the exterior are associated with 19th or early 20th century work.

Also on the property not far from the house is a small private cemetery with the graves of Ann Hebb who was born October 22, 1766 and died December 19, 1831, and Richard Hebb born May 22, 1766 and died January 28, 1835.


