DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame building appears to have been a country church. It is a one story, four bay German sided structure with a gable end entrance. A semi-circular fanlight is present in the peak of the gables. Windows are elongated with two over two pane sashes and are trimmed with flat topped architraves.


