DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This L-shaped brick farmhouse is a two story five bay structure with a two story, four bay wing with a double porch extending to the rear. The front of the building is constructed in Flemish bond while other areas display common bonding. Windows have narrow frames with six over six pane sashes held within narrow frames. The centrally placed entrance has eight panels.

A frame bank barn is present.






