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DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This large weatherboarded log house has an exceptionally refined exterior appearance relative to the majority of log houses in Washington County. It is a two story, four bay structure with a two story, three bay wing which would appear to be an addition. The main section of the house is quite tall with a large space between first and second story windows suggesting high ceilings at the interior. Nine over six pane sashes are present at both stories. According to a caretaker for the house, the main staircase is curved.



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
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
