This farmhouse was apparently built in three parts of which the most recent is a one story stone addition. Perpendicular to it are two parts, a two story, three bay aluminum sided log section and a two story, three bay brick section. The main entrance is in the brick section of the house. The two front structures have nine over six pane sashes at their upper levels.








