DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This stone farmhouse would appear to date from the second quarter of the 19th century. It is built of roughly coursed native limestone with small stones suggesting keystones above the windows. It is a two story four bay house which has been altered in the area of the front door. A stone wing extending to the rear has received modern additions.
