DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farmstead contains a two story, six bay log house sheathed with German siding. Apparently it had a recessed double porch at its two southernmost bays of the front or east elevation. The upper porch has since been enclosed with the same German siding that covers the rest of the building. Doors are located at random along the front elevation and some windows have six over six pane sashes. Some retain 19th century pointed topped architraves. A large frame bank barn is also present.


