Justification for decision: (Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map)
The Weicht farm complex consists of a two-story brick I-house with a later one story frame addition, stone springhouse, and a bank barn all dating from the mid-nineteenth century. In addition, there are several twentieth century outbuildings including a concrete block smoke house. Located in Downsville, the farm includes 38 acres off of Dellinger Road. The welling measures five bays wide and two bays deep with a center hall plan. Both front and back elevations (east and west) have a later victorian scroll work porch. A standing seem metal gable roof is intersected by two internal end chimneys and a central modern chimney. The interior was not accessible. The one and a half story spring house straddles the creek and spring and is capped by a metal gable roof. Finished with stucco, the springhouse includes a internal chimney and two opposing single sash windows. The bank barn is located southwest of the house and is characterized by a stone foundation, hand hewn, pegged beams, vertical siding and metal roof. Adjacent is a twentieth century concrete silo. Although retaining a high level of integrity in design, setting, location, materials and feeling, the property is representative of the county and region and does not embody distinctive characteristics of type, period or method of construction.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This brick house is a two story, five bay structure with a central entrance. The entrance includes a door hung beneath a broad transom and side lights. Windows have six over six pane sashes hung beneath wide wooden lintels. The general appearance of the house suggests a construction date during the mid 19th century, probably after 1850. Included in the complex is a stone and board and batten sided spring house and a frame bank barn.


