DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The buildings on Felfoot Farm include a two part stone and brick house, various stone domestic outbuildings and a stone barn. The stone section of the house said to be dated 1784, is a two story, four bay structure with flat arches of dressed stones above the first story windows. The stones are laid in relatively narrow courses. The entrance is topped with a rectangular transom which makes the entrance lintel wall higher than that of the windows. Added to this part of the house is a two story, four bay brick section of common bond at all elevations. It has a recessed double porch along its front elevation. A series of small stone outbuildings are located behind the house. Also, part of the complex is a stone end bank barn on which the date 1784 has been written. This does not appear to be the correct date for the barn although it probably does date from the 18th century.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Felfoot Farm is said, according to tradition, to have been a stopping place for Braddock's Army on their route to Fort Pitt in 1756. The barn, according to legend, was built for the purpose of storing provisions for the Army. Actually, it is more likely that the barn was built as part of the farm complex during the late 18th century. The land grant "Felfoot" is one of the oldest in Washington County.


