This complex consists of a two story, five bay brick house, a large frame bank barn and a log wash house covered with board and batten siding. The house has common bond brickwork at all elevations and had a recessed double porch along part of its front elevation which has been enclosed with German siding. Windows have six over six pane sashes.




