This farmstead features a large two story, seven bay brick house. The two more easterly bays of its south or front elevation are recessed beneath a double porch which has been partially enclosed. The five bays of the main facade have a central entrance. The building appears to have been painted white at one time. Also on the property, some distance from the house is a 20th century gambrel roofed frame barn.






